

# Katherine West Health Board Lajamanu Health Centre Landscape Works Progress Report June 2013

## Work undertaken

3 fortnight long trips have been undertaken (7-20 April, 28 April-11 May and 19 May-1 June). Don Duggan from Triodia Consultancy has supervised all work during these trips.

3 local workers were engaged to work on the project through Katherine West Health Board. 2 of the workers were enrolled in a *Certificate 1 in AgriFood Operations* (AHC10210) and have progressed well through the course. Accreditation will be provided in the near future. In addition to work carried out with Don they have carried on with their activities between trips with Don providing support over the phone. Don has drawn up a work plan for Tony Sampson and Emanuel Tilmouth who will carry on working on the project (supervised by Wulain and administered and paid by KWHB). 3 maintenance trips are scheduled for next financial year. Work completed includes:

- All earthworks and landscaping completed
- All irrigation is installed and final checks made
- Grass has been sown and has germinated
- Sand and rock mulch areas have been established
- All plants are installed and mulched, plants that have died have been replaced
- Plants and grassed areas have been fertilised
- Both shelters have been constructed

The community response from local yappa has been very encouraging. Katherine West Health Board staff have commented on the good progress and in particular the work ethic of the workers. Other yappa within the community have joined in voluntarily.
